The Gift of H&DCYC. One Sunday morning, just over 20 years ago, I was on my knees at church praying. The church

was inviting members to pray for God to show us what talents we have and how they can be used.

At that time my business was very demanding, so scheduled commitments were impractical, even arranging a holiday.

So while I was praying a man stood up at the front of the church asking for helpers at a kids camp.

Now, I love camping. It was for just one week per year. Also, had I enjoyed running football teams for boys.

So when I turned up at my first camp, I expected to be asked to do general chores or drive a minibus. To my horror, I was told I was a T.O. To which I said "What is T.O.?"

When I was told it meant taking care of 6 boys, I wondered what I had let myself in for.

Anyway to cut short a very long story. Thanks to the prayers and support of the camp leaders I and the boys in my tent survived that first week at Explorers and every other week in the following years.

At the end of every week, I am tired out but totally satisfied.

God's gift to me was an invitation, an offer that has rewarded and blessed me in so many ways.
